PRACTICE OVERVIEW

The Partnership of Perth Radiological Clinic (PRC) is based in Perth with 23 clinics across the greater Perth metropolitan area, with a new clinic opening in regional south-west (Bunbury) in 2026. PRC is the largest radiology provider in Western Australia. We provide radiology services to three major public hospitals with 24/7 Emergency Departments, three private hospitals and have a number of suburban clinics across Perth. PRC was created in 1948 and is a Radiologist owned Practice with an institutional investor as a minority shareholder.

PRC employs approximately 130 Radiologists and has a unique highly stratified sub-specialist model of reporting. The level of sub-specialist skills and reporting model is rarely seen anywhere in Australia. Our MSK sub-specialist team comprises 22 Fellowship trained sub-specialist Radiologists who are committed to providing excellent patient outcomes. The fleet of equipment includes 18 state of the art MRI scanners, and many more CT & US machines.

The purpose of the organisation is the provision of diagnostic imaging services of the highest quality to the Western Australian community. This is achieved by the Practice possessing a wide range of capabilities and skills, blended within an environment of youth and experience.

The Practice has an ongoing commitment of Radiologists to major teaching hospitals as well as participating in the RANZCR clinical radiology training program.

Additionally, the practice has an ongoing commitment of Radiologists to participate in subspecialist multidisciplinary meetings and education sessions at public and private hospitals. Across the practice, PRC radiologists attend over 40 MDTs every week, fortnight and month.

MSK FELLOWSHIP OVERVIEW

The Fellowship will consist of MSK related work, reflective of the case mix that passes through the three central clinics through which Fellows rotate. A minimum of 50% of time reporting MRI would be expected when allowing for procedures and non-MRI diagnostic work (the majority of which is MSK).

There will be ample exposure to MRI from our orthopaedic, sports medicine (including elite sports imaging) and rheumatological referrers in addition to procedures including musculoskeletal injections and tumour biopsies, supervised by PRC's expert MSK team who are at the forefront in the delivery of tertiary sarcoma imaging in the state.

Training and supervision will be provided for progressive development of the successful applicant's skills in these areas to achieve the confidence and competency required to practice as a MSK sub-specialist.

PRC offers a generous salary package compared to other Fellowships. The fellowship year consists of almost entirely MSK work (with minor general reporting requirements). The following year (consolidation year) requires a position as a consultant at PRC, which will provide the opportunity to further harness MSK skills but also work as a consultant in general settings.





JOB DESCRIPTION

The Partners of Perth Radiological Clinic are offering a privately funded MSK Fellowship in Perth, Western Australia. This is a post RANZCR qualification role following successful completion of 5 years of training.

This is a 12-month full-time Fellowship with 6 weeks annual leave and 2 weeks' study leave p.a. provided on average over the term of the Fellowship: -

- The Fellowship will consist almost entirely of MSK related work, reflective of the case mix that passes through the three central clinics through which Fellows would rotate.
- A minimum of 50% of time reporting MRI would be expected when allowing for procedures and non-MRI diagnostic work (the majority of which is MSK).
- Training will be provided to develop proficiency in a wide range of CT, ultrasound and fluoroscopically guided injections and tumour biopsies.
- Attendance and preparation for Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) meetings within the practice or at major
 Teaching hospitals to be determined by the MSK Fellowship Supervisor. Allowance in particular will be made
 for involvement in the weekly sarcoma meeting.
 Possible roster Refer Appendix 1.
- Presentations at key forums as mutually agreed with the MSK Fellowship Supervisor.
- Identification and discussion of interesting cases and research.
- Record of competency and proficiency will be maintained. Regular feedback on progression will be provided against expected criteria at each stage of development.
- Contribution to the library of interesting cases.
- Participation in research activities including satisfactory completion of at least one supervised research
 project and publication in a peer reviewed journal. There may also be the opportunity to be involved in the
 research projects of our referrers.
- > Probationary period and Performance Review. There is a 6-month probationary period during which we will assess your suitability for the position, with a formal performance review 3 & 6 months after commencing employment and then annually.
- > Additional injection lists may be available sporadically on weekends when the Fellow shows sufficient proficiency. This will be paid at a premium rate compared to the Fellow salary.
- > Fellows will be required to participate in two general sessions rostered on weekends per month as part of the contract, to be paid on top of your package as a Fellow. Sessions are 4.5 hours in duration.
- > The successful applicant will be a full-time employee of PerthRadClinic Ltd, service entity to the Perth Radiological Clinic partnership, paid as a Fellow for the first year and as a consultant Radiologist for one year post Fellowship. The salary for the consultancy role will be negotiable at the time of interview and will be at competitive market rate for a post MSK Fellowship trained consultant.
- > The contract will include one fully paid trip to a major MSK/MRI meeting in Australia subject to presentation of a paper/poster from work in the Fellowship, or other representation of PRC, expenditure capped at \$5,000 and one year membership of AMSIG (Australasian Musculoskeletal Imaging Group) which is the main MSK radiology interest group in Australia.



Consultant position: 12 months consolidation post Fellowship

Consolidation year (market rate package) enhancing knowledge and proficiency in a clinical setting, location subject to Medicare Provider Number limitations, working 4-5 days a week in the practice with a mix of reporting and procedural work, while continuing to develop your MSK knowledge.

REMUNERATION

A competitive salary package is being offered. Salary range for the Fellowship year would be at a premium compared to Public Hospital Fellowship positions. Post Fellowship year remuneration will be negotiated at the same time as the Fellowship at a competitive market rate for a Fellowship trained MSK consultant in radiology.

Additional remuneration can be earned undertaking non-compulsory out of hours work-paid at market rate.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- Registered with AHPRA
- RANZCR accredited
- Eligible for Medicare Provider Numbers (restrictions to be assessed).
- Demonstrates commitment to being an effective team member and contributing positively to team culture and performance
- Professional and respectful in dealings with colleagues, patients, and other staff in addition to referrers and external organisations
- Strong commitment to the pursuit of musculoskeletal radiology as a dedicated subspeciality, including MSK procedures
- Enthusiastic, accurate and productive in the reporting of radiology studies
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

· Active interest in research, teaching and other aspects of radiology beyond daily reporting duties

Please include the following with your application:

- Current curriculum vitae
- Three written references or the contact details of three suitable referees who would be open to a verbal discussion
- A covering letter including a statement addressing the above selection criteria, a statement of goals what you would like to achieve from the PRC MSK Fellowship, and details of current level of proficiency in musculoskeletal radiology diagnostic studies and procedures
- Successful applicants will require a satisfactory police and visa clearance and must be able to commit to a 12-month consolidation year as a consultant with PRC immediately following the 12-month MSK fellowship.

Once applications are assessed, interviews will be arranged with shortlisted candidates.
